

Presentation

This diploma is intended for international students who wish to improve their command of French and pursue scientific studies by enrolling in a Master's programme at our University.

The prerequisites are an **A2** level of French and a Bachelor's degree or be in the process of obtaining one (final phase).

Objectives

A2 ► B2+ ► Direct access to a Master of Science



Program

- ▶ 400 hours of French as a Foreign Language (FLE) with specialized teachers
- ▶ 60 hours of immersion in the language lab
- ▶ 40 hours of guided independent study at the CRL
- ▶ Cultural activities

Assessment methods :

- Continuous assessment : participation, assignments, presentations.
- Final exam : written and oral comprehension/expression, FOU/FOS project.
- Certification : CLES B2 exam at the end of Semester 2.
- Validation of cultural outings : report or presentation.
- Validation of internship : report and defense for students who have chosen this option

- ▶ Duration : 1 year in 2 semesters
- ▶ Class size limited to 20 students
- ▶ Dates : September to June
- ▶ 500 hours of instruction

Semester 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General French as a Foreign Language (FLE) : 110h → Grammar, written/oral expression, comprehension, practical life skills, and French culture • Academic French (FOU) and French for Specific Purposes (FOS) – Sciences: 80h → Specialized vocabulary, university note-taking, report writing • Immersion : 30h → Immersion in lectures and tutorials related to students' specializations • Cultural activities : 10h → Visits to museums, monuments, local events, intercultural encounters • CRL : 20h → Guided independent work: innovative language software, supervision and monitoring by French tutors, games workshops, interactions, etc
Semester 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FLE : 90h → Advanced study, preparation for certifications (CLE B2) • FOS – FOU : 100h → Writing document summaries, internship reports, oral scientific presentations • Cultural activities : 10h • CRL : 20h • Laboratory/practical training internship: 30h → Immersion in research laboratories, practical training



Tuition fees : **€3,500** including textbooks, language certification, and cultural activities

+ administrative fees (CVEC) and accommodation, payable by students


To register :

► Applications open from January 20 to March 6, 2026 via [e-candidat](#)

► Required supporting documents (in English or French):

- Transcripts for LI, L2, SI, and L3 (even if provisional). If you have a 4-year bachelor's degree, provide transcripts for the first 3 years.
- Course syllabus
- Cover letter explaining your plans
- Resume
- French language proficiency test
- English language proficiency (required for certain programs)
- Rank, classification (optional)
